Skovsøen, the Danish Language Village

- Summer sessions lasting one, two or four weeks, including high school credit sessions
- Family Weekends
- Teacher Seminar for Danish language educators
- Master of Education in World Language Instruction

Aktiviteter på Skovsøen.



Life at *Skovsøen* is infused with Danish. Participants become “villagers” and live in the language and culture from the moment they wake up — participating in small language learning groups, cultural and camp activities, sports, dance, song — to the close of the day. Counselors from the United States and Denmark, as well as Danes from around the world, engage with villagers and share experiences using repetition and actions to increase understanding and retention.



Where

- One site: culturally and architecturally authentic, surrounded by the North Woods on Turtle River Lake near Bemidji, Minn.

Facts about Danish Language and Culture

Danish Language Speakers

- Worldwide: more than 6 million speakers
- Official language of Denmark
- Also spoken in Faroe Islands and Greenland
- Officially recognized and protected as a minority language in Germany

Alphabet

Uses 26 Latin letters, as well as three additional vowels at the end of the alphabet: æ, ø, and å

Skovsøen activities:

- Woodworking
- Arts and crafts
- Festivals and celebrations
- Traditional cooking
- Music and folk dance
- Optional: extensive biking and camping trip through Itasca State Park
- Sports like swimming and soccer

All activities conducted in Danish.
