

Salolampi

Finnish Language Village 2011



Location

Built to replicate Finnish architecture, *Salolampi* is located on Turtle River Lake near Bemidji, Minn. Finnish architectural style is apparent throughout the Village.

Sessions

The one-week Exploratory Session for students ages 7-11 introduces villagers to a variety of cultural and language-learning activities.

Two-week Immersion Sessions, for students ages 8-13 or 11-18, expand on the exploratory programs, introducing villagers to political and environmental issues.

A four-week High School Credit Session is available for students ages 14-18 who want a more intensive study of Finnish at any level of language proficiency. Successful completion of the course fulfills credit requirements for one year of high school world language study. The credit program offers 180 hours of language and cultural instruction in an experiential environment. (Minnesota's State Board of Education requires a minimum of 120 hours for one unit of credit.)

During Family Week, parents and/or grandparents and children can experience *Salolampi* together.

Soiva Music Camp at *Salolampi* is a partnership between Concordia Language Villages, the Association of Finnish Music Schools, the *Salolampi* Foundation, Concordia College, Bemidji State University and the Finlandia Foundation. Participants ages 9-18 must have a minimum of two years private instruction in piano, clarinet, flute, violin, cello composition or improvisation.

Music instruction is in English by teachers from Finland and from the United States and takes place at the music department of Bemidji State University. Participants live at *Salolampi*, where the regular *Salolampi* staff leads them in an immersion experience in Finnish language and culture.

Scholarships

Scholarships are offered to *Salolampi* participants by the *Salolampi* Foundation and Concordia Language Villages.

The Village

In the forest of birch and pine in northern Minnesota is nestled a bit of Finland. *Salolampi*, Finnish for "Lake in the Woods," is one of 15 Concordia Language Villages. All 15 Villages have the mission to prepare young people for responsible citizenship in our global community. Concordia Language Villages promotes this goal by instilling in young people an enthusiasm for and an appreciation of world languages and cultures.

Finnish "villagers" are immersed in Finnish language and culture during one-, two-, and four-week sessions. Upon arrival at *Salolampi*, villagers present their Concordia Languages Villages passports to customs officials, select Finnish names and exchange their money for euros.

Villagers learn the Finnish language through a wide variety of cultural activities such as arts and crafts, sports, dancing, and singing. All villagers participate in evening programs celebrating Finnish heritage, culture, holidays and folklore, as well as exploring environmental and political issues.

Spoken language is emphasized during large and small-group sessions in which villagers learn language through games and simulations.

Salolampi's enthusiastic staff of Finns and Americans includes counselors, credit teachers, special-program leaders, kitchen staff, waterfront staff, and healthcare providers.

Costs

Costs include tuition, food, lodging, and instruction. A deposit is required with each application. Refer to the registration form for deposit information. Checks are made payable to Concordia Language Villages.

Villagers are responsible for transportation costs to and from *Salolampi*. You will receive transportation information once your registration is received.

Scholarships

All *Salolampi* villagers will receive scholarship assistance offered by the Salolampi Foundation in cooperation with Concordia Language Villages. The Salolampi Foundation awarded \$32,649 in scholarships in 2010. In addition, \$8,785 in Concordia Language Villages scholarships was awarded to *Salolampi* villagers. Some villagers also received need-based scholarships.

Check Out These Scholarships

We encourage you to study the **increased scholarship offerings**, and by planning, you can reduce tuition costs substantially. **Note due dates.** Make contacts early.

Upper Peninsula Scholarships Youth from 497, 498 or 499 zip code areas are eligible to apply on a first-come basis for either a \$150 one-week, \$250 two-week or \$450 four-week scholarship. (Available until \$2,000 is expended.)

SUOMI-KOULU Scholarships A \$100 scholarship for a villager who has attended a Suomi-koulu (Finnish Saturday School). Download an application from www.salolampi.org or write to info@salolampi.org or the Salolampi Foundation by April 1, 2011. (Available until \$1,000 is expended.)

Go from One-Week to Two-Weeks A villager who has attended a one-week session and enrolls in a two-week session will be eligible for a \$100 scholarship. (Available until \$1,000 is expended.)

Allie Luoma Family Week Scholarships A \$50 scholarship will be awarded to each family member who registers for the Family Week June 13-18, 2011. (Available until \$2,000 is expended.)

Travel Scholarships Enrollees in the two-week and four-week sessions from the east, west and south coastal states, plus Alaska, Arizona, New Mexico, and Hawaii, receive \$125. Enrollees from all other states, excluding, Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, Iowa and Wisconsin will receive \$75. (Available until \$2,000 is expended.)

New this Year! Soiva One-Week to Two-Weeks A villager who has attended a one-week *Soiva* session and enrolls for the first time in a two-week *Salolampi* session will be eligible for a \$150 *Salolampi* session scholarship.

Registration Policies

The date items are considered "received" is determined by the postmark or timestamp on the letter, fax, or e-mail. Non-refundable deposit is due upon registration. Full tuition for summer programs must be paid by June 1. Registrations after June 1 must be paid in full at time of registration. Account statements will be sent monthly beginning in January

Online registrations will be assigned available space in real time. Paper registrations are assigned available space as they are manually processed.

Given our mission and the program that has been designed to support that mission, receipt of your child's registration confirms that your child is able to independently:

- Meet his/her personal needs such as getting dressed, showering and eating;
- Move from place to place; and
- Effectively interact in our group-based and community-living environment.

Villagers sent home due to disciplinary reasons, homesickness, or inability to manage pre-existing medical, mental, emotional or social health conditions will not receive a refund.

The villager experience is based on a communal living environment with shared bathroom and shower facilities, and therefore villagers are housed only in same-sex groupings.

Health Concerns:

Please be aware that due to the cultural immersion aspect of our program, culturally authentic snacks and meals are an integral part of the experience. We are not able to guarantee an environment that is free of aerosolized allergens. Please contact our Health Services office to address specific concerns or questions regarding allergies before registering. (218-586-8771 or erceg@cord.edu)

Our program may not be a good fit for some people with a mental/emotional health diagnosis. If you have a concern, please contact our Health Services office prior to registering.

For villagers enrolled in Summer Programs (June - August): Villager Health Forms must be completed and returned to our Health Services office by May 1; or, for late enrollments, 3 weeks prior to the session. Information is shared with staff only on a need-to-know basis. Villagers are expected to arrive healthy and able to participate. We reserve the right not to admit a person who poses a communicable illness threat.

Cancellation Policy:

ALL DEPOSITS FOR SUMMER SESSIONS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE

PRIOR TO May 1:

If cancellation is received by April 30 a 100% percent refund of the total paid tuition will be given minus the non-refundable deposit.

MAY 1 THRU MAY 31:

If a cancellation is received May 1 – 31 a 50% refund will be given of the total paid tuition minus the non-refundable deposit. Upon cancellation all discounts will be forfeited. Any remaining balance due must still be paid.

JUNE 1 AND AFTER:

If a cancellation is received on or after June 1 no refunds will be given. Villagers who do not report to a session will not receive a refund. No adjustment in tuition is made for late arrival, early departure, or dismissal. All refunds must be requested within 30 days of session end date. After a refund is approved, it will be processed within 30 days. All deposits are non-refundable.

We reserve the right to cancel or withdraw any program without notice. Concordia Language Villages is not responsible for costs incurred by a participant in preparing for a program that has been altered or cancelled. A completed and processed application denotes that the signer understands and agrees that Concordia Language Villages reserves the right at any time to alter these terms and regulations and other conditions stated within the Parent Handbook and other literature printed by Concordia Language Villages.

Check Processing Policy:

When you provide a check as payment to Concordia College or Concordia Language Villages, you authorize us either to use the information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check transaction. When information from your check is used by Concordia College or Concordia Language Villages to make an electronic fund transfer, funds may be withdrawn from your account as soon as the same day you make your payment, and you will not receive your check back from your financial institution. To ensure proper credit to correct account be sure to include the participants name in the memo line. A \$25 service fee or the maximum amount allowed by law will be added to all returned checks. Returned check fees may be collected electronically via ACH.
