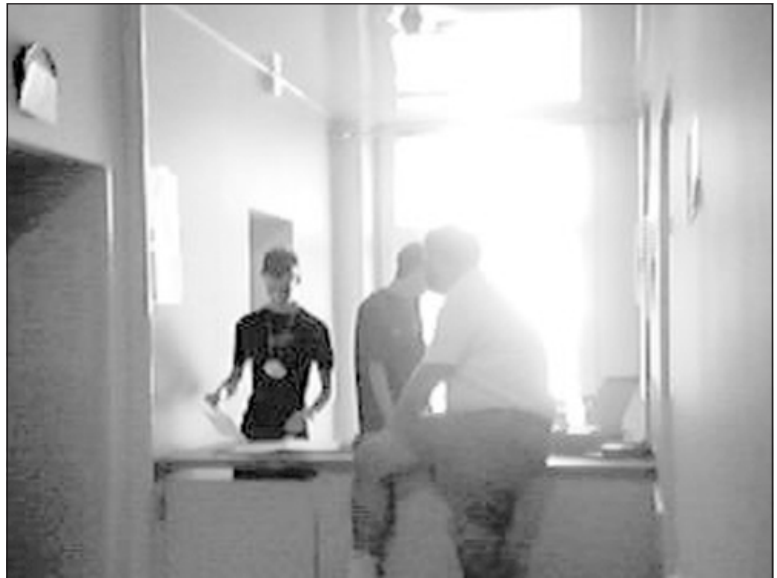


Store opens on 2nd Floor
